

#### What is Baby Bounce?

Baby Bounce is about using rhymes, songs and books to introduce the sounds and rhythm of language. It helps babies to understand that words and pictures tell stories and have meaning, and increases vocabulary.

It is also about making connections in the community during the early years of parenthood.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

**When to arrive?** Give yourself and baby enough time to be ready by 10:30 or so. You can enter either via the lagoon door, which leads you straight to the children's area, or through the main library doors on level 1, then take the lift down to level 0.

**How long does it go for?** About 25–30 mins. There is plenty of time and space afterwards to stretch, mingle, have a snack, browse books, talk about memberships, and join the library.

**What to bring?** You don't need to bring anything, but a baby rug can be helpful for tummy time.

**How to book?** The program is designed to be experienced as a series of four different sessions, come to as many as works for you. For the best experience, you will need one lap per baby. For parents of multiples, bring along extra adults if you can. Book your free place/s via our What's On page. Tickets are available one week before each session.



Each Baby Bounce session has songs, rhymes, some time for board book reading, and a fun activity, like playing with silk scarves, musical instruments or bubbles. Here are some of the favourite songs and action rhymes from our regular Baby Bounce sessions:





E, I, E, I, O,



You put your baby up










#### The Fish in the Sea



#### **Helpful Tips and Tricks**

#### **Bouncing Fun**

- Bounce your baby while facing you.
- Sing to them so they can watch your mouth and learn how words are formed.
- Bouncing helps them feel rhythm and prepares them for walking, running, and dancing.

#### **Scarves & Shakers**

- Use scarves and shakers to help with fine motor skills like holding, dropping, and waving.
- Play peek-a-boo and tickling games to teach new words and sounds.
- Gently touch your baby with the scarf or shaker while naming body parts to improve vocabulary.



#### **Tummy Time**

- Engage with Pictures: Point to and describe pictures to keep them interested.
- Short Sessions: Start with a few minutes and gradually increase the time.
- Comfortable Surface: Ensure your baby is on a soft, safe surface.
- Use Board Books: Place them in front of your baby during tummy time to encourage lifting their head.



#### Why Board Books?

Board books are fantastic for babies for several reasons:

Durable: Thick pages withstand rough handling.

Safe: Rounded edges and non-toxic materials.

Engaging: Bright pictures and simple text.

Interactive: Textures, flaps, and mirrors.

Easy to Handle: Perfect size for little hands.

#### **Reading to Your Baby**

Reading board books to your baby is a great way to introduce them to language, stories, and bonding. Here are some tips to make it fun and beneficial:

#### Make It Interactive

- Point and name things in the pictures.
- Ask simple questions like, "Where's the dog?"
- Use your baby's name to personalise the story.

#### **Use Your Voice**

- Vary your tone to keep them interested.
- Show emotions with your voice to match the story.

#### **Keep It Short**

- Read for 5-10 minutes.
- Follow your baby's lead if they lose interest.



#### **Engage Their Senses**

- Let them touch textures in the book.
- Help them turn pages to develop motor skills.

#### **Let Them Explore**

Allow them to handle and explore the book.

#### **Choose Simple, Bold Pictures**

• Pick books with high-contrast images and bright colours.

#### **Be Patient and Repeat Stories**

- Babies love repetition; it helps with learning.
- Let them skip pages or go back if they want.

#### **Use Rhymes and Repetition**

• Rhyming books are great for language skills.

#### **Talk About Pictures**

• Describe what's happening in the pictures.

#### **Create a Routine**

- Make reading a calm, inviting activity.
- Read at the same time each day to build a routine.

#### **Story Box Library**
